These fees, as permitted by state law, may be debited as a paper draft or an electronic funds transfer, at our option. Each dishonored item is subject to the applicable state returned check fees. Specifically, per Florida Statute § 68.065, the service fee for returned checks is as follows: \$25, if the face value does not exceed \$50; \$30, if the face value exceeds \$50 but does not exceed \$300; \$40, if the face value exceeds \$300 or 5% of the face amount of the check, whichever is greater. (Note that the fee structure will change according to any amendments made to FL law during a school year.)
