

Did you know that introducing young children to a second language can give them a chance at greater fluency and access to professional opportunities later on? Spanish is the second most-spoken language in the world according to census reports.

The Language Enrichment Exploration (L.E.E.) is excited to announce that after school Spanish classes are coming to Mill Creek and currently enrolling for the January sessions. L.E.E. is a program offered to all regular and extended day students at the school. The program is designed to encourage students to develop a love for Spanish while offering language instruction. This program was founded in 2003 and there are currently 13 participating schools in the St. Johns County School District. In addition, for the last 11 consecutive years, a L.E.E. student has won the Scholar of the Year award for Elementary at the State level, a recognition sponsored by the Florida Foreign Language Association (FFLA). The program starts the week of January 9 and meets once a week (Mondays) for fifteen (15) 90-minute sessions. The cost of the program is \$255. 
## Yearbook Cover Contest
