Welcome back to the 2016 - 2017 school year. I am so excited about what the new year holds for us as a learning community. From day one our students were engaged in learning! Throughout the classrooms, you can see students thinking. I have listened to the learning conversations and viewed student work that is already beginning to emerge. Our "trailblazers" have kicked learning into high-gear with a mindset to only get SMARTER, and more RIGOROUS. I want to begin our first newsletter with a few key parent communication avenues that will keep you updated on the current events and learning practices throughout the year:

REMIND: This year, we will continue to utilize REMIND as a parent communication in addition to blackboard. REMIND is a simple text features that allows me to send our entire Mill Creek community reminders of important information. Check out the REMIND link located on the MCES home page to sign up.

Mill Creek Messenger: The Mill Creek Messenger is the weekly school newsletter. I use this platform to educate our parents of instructional practices, deepen the understanding of our instructional practices, learning goals, and standards for our parents and families, and keep you updated on current events. In addition, I use the newsletter as reminders, safety tips, and frequent communication. In addition to my informational piece, other important information is shared throughout the newsletter from various departments at Mill Creek. This year we are excited to highlight our Resource classes each month and the learning experiences that are offered to students each day. This is a highlight of our student's day!

Mill Creek webpage: Mill Creek's webpage is not only informative, but we work to keep it interactive with videos and learning in the building. Our webmaster, Mrs. Kathleen Richards, in addition to Mrs. Tompkins, updates the site weekly. Please never hesitate to let us know if you view information on our website that is not updated!

Curriculum Nights (formerly called OPEN HOUSE) September 13(PreK – 2nd grade) and September 15 (3rd -5th grade): This year we will continue to hose our Curriculum Night. However, to accommodate our growing number of students, we will host two nights, **September 13 for grade PreK, Kindergarten, 1st, and 2nd grade and September 15 for 3'^d, 4th, and 5th grade.** Although the evening will be spent with grade level and individual classroom teachers and becoming acquainted with specific classroom practices, the highlight of the evening will be a focus on student learning and what is expected from students during the course of the year. We are encouraging our parents to make this an "adult only" evening so parents are truly able to engage in the learning expectations, classroom rituals and routines and be able to ask the very important questions that you may have about your child's year of learning. We realize that for some of our families this is difficult; however, we are asking that parents plan to attend this event without their children. This will be the only time we ask throughout the year for an adult only evening as we know and are committed to Mill Creek being a child-centered organization. Thank you in advance for your flexibility and support.

Finally, I wanted to remind our parents of **parent drop off and pick up**. Although the first few days have taken a little longer, we are proud to have decreased our time significantly with over 1100 students. In fact, we have had a very successful dismissal that has been celebrated throughout the district. That is only done with the help and support of our AMAZING families! THANK YOU SO

MUCH!!!! As a reminder, we request that parents please remain in their vehicles and use the Parent Pick Up line. I realize it is timeconsuming, but for the safety of our students, it is imperative that we do not have parents gathered outside the doors waiting for their students. In addition, I wanted to remind parents that students can be dropped off in the morning at 8:05. If you arrive early students will be asked to remain outside until 8:10. A Mill Creek staff member will supervise this group until students move into the building. This ensures students arrive safe and secure for a successful day of learning!
