National Junior Honor Society Mill Creek Academy Application Process

In order to be considered for membership into the Mill Creek Academy Chapter of the National Junior Honor Society, you must follow all instructions.

1. Applications will be available for 7th graders beginning November 1 – November 15.
2. Completed forms are to be returned to **Mrs. Arnold**, room **606**, by **November 15, 2019 at 2:50pm**.
3. A faculty selection committee will review the applications and recommendations for final selections. Selection letters will be delivered prior to Winter Break.
4. Students selected for membership will be invited, with their families, to attend the Induction Ceremony to be held April 2020.

Deadline for application: 2:50pm on November 15, 2019

****LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED****

The application form must include:

- a. Rights and Responsibility Form
- b. COPY of your most recent report card: The report card is used to determine if you meet the GPA requirement of a 3.75. GPA* **does not** guarantee acceptance into the National Junior Honor Society program. Please be sure to calculate and include your GPA.
- c. Leadership Form
- d. Service Form
- e. Citizenship Form
- f. Character Form
- g. Three teacher recommendation forms: It is your responsibility to put your name on the forms. You can only use 1 recommendation from a previous year's teacher.

***If you are unsure if you meet the GPA requirement, you can use gpacalculator.net to determine your eligibility. Use the high school calculator and set credits to 1. An advanced class is equivalent to an honor class. Do NOT include electives.

National Junior Honor Society Rights and Responsibilities Form

7. To complete 10 hours of school service per school year.
8. To continue to demonstrate superior qualities of scholarship, service to others, leadership and character
9. To pay dues of \$10. Dues include membership pin and t-shirt.
