- 1. Applications will be available for 7th and 8<sup>th</sup> graders beginning December 10
- 2. Completed forms are to be returned to Mrs. Arnold, room 606, by January 8, 2021 at Dismissal 3:00pm.
- 3. A faculty selection committee will review the applications and recommendations for final selections. Selection letters will be delivered the week of January 25
- **4.** Students selected for membership will be invited, with their families, to attend the Induction Ceremony to be held April 2021.

\*\*LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED and APPLICATON NEED TO BE FULLY COMPLETED, \*\*

To be considered for membership, your application **must** include **all** of the following:

- a. Rights and Responsibility Form
- b. COPY of your most recent report card: The report card is used to determine if you meet the GPA requirement of a 3.75. GPA\* does not guarantee acceptance into the National Junior Honor Society program. Please be sure to calculate and include your GPA
- c. Leadership Form
- d. Service Form
- e. Citizenship Form
- f. Character Form
- g. Give out three teacher recommendation forms for your teachers to complete: It is your responsibility to put your name on the forms. You can only use 1 recommendation from a previous year's teacher. Teachers providing your recommendations will turn these in, confidentially to Mrs. Arnold.
