

Coordinated Screening and Progress Monitoring System Overview

Background

Section [1008.25\(8\)](#), F.S., requires the implementation of a Coordinated Screening and Progress Monitoring System for Voluntary Prekindergarten (VPK) Education Programs and public schools serving kindergarten through grade 8 students beginning with the 2022–23 school year. Cambium Assessment, Incorporated (CAI), partnered with Renaissance Learning, Incorporated (RL), has been selected as the vendor for this program. These two vendors have a long history of successful partnerships with the Department to deliver statewide summative assessments (CAI), as well as FLKRS and the VPK assessment pilot (RL). For VPK–Grade 2, schools will administer RL’s Star Early Literacy (VPK), Star Reading (Grades 1–2), and Star Mathematics assessments. For Grades 3–8, schools will administer assessments through CAI’s existing online platform already in use in Florida, expanded to be used in all assessed grades. CAI and RL have committed to delivering a coordinated screening and progress monitoring system that will meet all the requirements set forth in HB 419 and HB 7011.

Senate Bill 1048

Senate Bill 1048 was passed by the Florida legislature and includes the following assessment-related changes:

- Removes the requirement that grades 3–6 assessments be delivered in a paper-based format.
- Replaces the current grade-level summative assessment system with the Coordinated Screening and Progress Monitoring System required in section [1008.25\(8\)](#), F.S.

Because the new law requires ELA for grades 3–10, the contract with CAI will be amended to include grades 9 and 10 for ELA assessments.

Action

Per 1008.25(8), these assessments will be administered three times per year, with the first administration occurring within the first 30 instructional days. Online management and results reporting for these assessments will not change from the current systems in use (TIDE and PearsonAccess Next).

Process of Implementation

VPK:

- Renaissance Star Early Literacy (no math)
- 3 times/year (progress monitoring)
- Computer-based and adaptive
- 1st administration within first 30 instructional days
- Headphones required

K-2:

- Renaissance Star Early Literacy/Reading and Star Mathematics
- 3 times/year (progress monitoring)
- Computer-based and adaptive
- One session per subject
- 1st administration within first 30 instructional days
- Headphones required

Grades 3-8 reading, math, and science:

- Cambium reading and math assessments aligned to the BEST standards
- 3 times/year (first 2 administrations progress monitoring, 3rd administration summative)
Computer-based
2022-23 is baseline year (results will not be used for accountability)
- 2023-24 and beyond results from 3rd administration used for accountability (school grades, ESSA, etc.)
- 5th and 8th grade Science- Not impacted by the new law. Will remain paper based.
