### **Writing in Action!**

Next Tuesday, March 6, our 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> graders will take the FSA Writing Assessment. Throughout the building students engage in writing daily and are making great gains as accomplished authors. Writing in different genres - narrative, opinion, and essay, has given students the opportunity to learn different writing crafts and strategies in addition to learning how to use their writing as a platform for expressing their thoughts and ideas. For example, we teach students how to use "show not tell" strategies. We want our students to use their voice to show how characters are feeling, not just tell us about the characters.

As lead learners in the classrooms, teachers have engaged in ongoing learning together to build a deeper understanding of elaboration and the impact we can have on student writing when we study together vertically, K-5. Ensuring that our students are proficient writers means that we must understand and agree upon what writing looks like and how we will grow our writers each year. This isn't new at Mill Creek, as we believe that to provide the highest level of educational experiences to our students, but we must continue to learn and grow as professionals.

As we come upon FSA Writes next week, we are confident in the writing our students are doing. Through feedback from teachers and peers, our students have shown growth in using elaboration and voice to move their writing forward. Ask your child to share his or her most recent writing with you and what was done, as a writer, to ensure the reader was influenced by their writing!

A few testing reminders as we move forward:

It is critically important that our students come with a well-prepared mind and body to do their BEST work. Please ensure that your child gets a good night's sleep, a well-balanced breakfast and most importantly is **HERE** and **ON TIME** to school next Tuesday. This will set them up for SUCCESS. Thank you in advance for your support and commitment to your child's education and the continued learning at Mill Creek. Our learning community's strength comes from your constant love, dedication, and support!!! THANK YOU.
