

Mill Creek is Filling Up with Mustang P-R-I-D-E!





MAY is Better Speech and Hearing Month

Although <u>MAY</u> is better speech and hearing month, <u>MAY</u> we remind you that it is never too late for you to do your part to help friends and loved ones conserve their hearing and improve their speaking abilities. <u>MAY</u> we suggest that you start early by helping your children to remember to speak in appropriate tones and not yell to others. <u>MAY</u> we also recommend that you do your part by listening to the car radio at an acceptable volume so that you <u>MAY</u> conserve the hearing that your children have and ensure that, as adults, they will enjoy the ability to hear their own children speak.



Hearing loss is not discriminatory and it is possible that even young adults <u>MAY</u> experience difficulties with their hearing. Long term illnesses and allergies MAY also nega-

tively impact your hearing. To determine if your hearing is in fact up to par, a physicians help <u>MAY</u> be necessary. If you have questions or concerns about your child's speech or hearing abilities you <u>MAY</u> contact Mill Creek Elementary Schools Speech-Language Pathologist's, Mrs. Jennifer Burton, M. S. CCC-SLP (on campus Monday through Friday), Mrs. Sharon McInerney M. A. CCC-SLP (on campus Monday and Wednesday) or Mrs. Renee Brooke M. S. CCC-SLP (on campus Thursday and Friday).
