Welcome Back, Mighty Mustang Friends and Family. What an honor it is to continue to serve our Mill Creek community! Each year we welcome students with a fierce passion and commitment to learning! Students have kicked off this school year taking pride in their learning, showing excellence and courage in trying new things, and most importantly having the desire to be vested learners. Students have already been engaged in collaborative learning conversations with peers and teachers and their work has shown evidence of learning that "stuck" from the year before! The common, predictable schoolwide structures are familiar to our students and give students the ability to focus on learning and what we like to say, "all the unpredictable thinking" to occur! We constantly remind ourselves of the opportunities we have been given to touch the lives of our students! Our commitment remains strong, unfailing, and relentless as we guarantee that we will continue to meet the needs of every child, every day! I wanted to begin our first newsletter with a few key parent communication modes that will keep you updated on the current events and learning practices throughout the year:

Mill Creek Webpage – Our webmasters, Mrs. Kathleen Richards and Mrs. Kathleen Tompkins, update the site weekly. It is a great tool for you to visit regularly for learning and event updates. Please do not hesitate to let us know if you view information on our website that is not updated.

Mustang Messenger – The Mill Creek Messenger is the weekly school newsletter. I use this platform to educate and deepen the understanding of instructional practices, learning goals, and standards. In addition, I use it as a way to communicate reminders, safety tips, and frequent communication that is important to the Mill Creek community as a whole.

Curriculum Chat Night (Open House) – September 12 – Families will have the opportunity to choose from ONE of the TWO information sessions offered this evening. We ask families to choose a session and make plans to attend from the beginning of the session time. This helps us maintain a respectful environment for all families during each session time. Times are **Session 1: 5:30 – 6:15 or Session 2 – 6:30 – 7:15**. We are encouraging our families to make this an "adult only" evening so parents are truly able to engage in the learning expectations, classroom rituals and routines. It is a great opportunity to ask the very important questions you may have about your child's year of learning. We realize that for some of our families this is difficult, however, if possible, we are asking that parents plan to attend this event without their children. This is the only time we ask for an adult only evening as we know and are committed to Mill Creek being a child-centered organization. Thank you in advance for your flexibility and support as we engage our parents and guardians in an evening of becoming active participants in their child's education.

Parent Pick Up and Drop Off— We request parents please remain in their vehicles and use the Parent Pick Up line. I realize it is time-consuming, but for the safety of our students, it is imperative that we do not have parents gathered outside the doors waiting for their students. Student safety is a priority. I want to extend my appreciation for your patience, flexibility, and support as we have worked through our arrival and dismissal times. Your effort has been noticed and has helped tremendously as we ensure the safety of our students during this time.

Our goal is for Every child, Every Need, Every Day to be served in an environment of excellence. We encourage you to become an active participant in your child's education and look forward to serving as your teacher and leader. PLEASE TAKE NOTE:

- 1. **Celebration Treats**—All celebration treats brought into the building MUST have an ingredients label and MUST be checked before going beyond the front office. NO HOMEMADE treats will be allowed on campus.
- 2. Lunch Account Balance—You will be contacted by the food service manager if your student has a negative lunch account balance of (\$10.00). We will no longer send notices home with students when the account is running low.
- 4. **Early Dismissals**—If your child is leaving early please send in a note to your child's teacher stating the need and reason for the early checkout request. To assist our front office please pick up your child before 2:30pm on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday and by 1:30pm on Wednesdays. We will not call for students to leave class until you arrive in the office.
- 5. Transportation Changes—Should you need to change your child's dismissal transportation, please email or send a written note to your child's teacher BEFORE 8:00 AM. If there is a situation during the day and a change in normal dismissal is needed please email <u>mcestransportation@stjohns.k12.fl.us</u> BEFORE 2 PM (1 PM on Wednesdays). Include your child's name, grade, teacher and how they need to get home. We can not accept phone calls for transportation changes.
- 6. **Health**—Please remember that if children are sent home with illness or out sick, they must be free of vomiting, diarrhea or fever without the aid of medication for 24 hours before they can return to school.
- Lunch Visitors Our students are doing a great job learning our café procedures and expectations. Visitors are allowed to have lunch in the café beginning September 5.







School Access

As required by Florida state law, everyone MUST have a cleared background check to go past the front office at Mill Creek Elementary. Picture ID (driver's license) is also required to enter the building at all times.

You MUST have a background check and be cleared to volunteer at the school, attend any conferences, attend field trips, and to have lunch with your child.

So, now is the time to go ahead and apply for school access! Please make sure all spouses, grandparents, siblings over the age of 18, etc. who may visit the school are also approved to enter the building.

The school access application is online at the Mill Creek website: <u>www-mce.stjohns.k12.fl.us</u> On the right side of the front page click on parent information- then click

click on parent information- then click school access. Make sure to designate Mill Creek Elementary so we receive the application. Enter your information and finish by clicking submit.

You will be contacted via email should you choose to include it in the application when you have been cleared. The cleared application is good for 3 years and can be updated in the front office or renewed at any time.

<u>At no time should you resubmit</u> <u>another application.</u>
