

IReady Testing Information

In order to get the best possible results from your child, we are asking you to bring your child to MCA on the following dates and times to take their iReady Assessments.

Each grade level will be assigned 2 days for math and 2 days for reading. If on day one your child is finished with the test, they will bring home a slip of paper that states they are finished. If they need to return for a third day, your child will have a slip of paper that states the day they need to return to finish their assessment.

Math iReady

October 1 and 2 – 3rd Grade

October 5 and 6 – 2nd Grade

October 8 and 9 – 1st Grade

October 12 and 13 – Kindergarten

Reading iReady

October 15 and 16 – 3rd Grade

October 19 and 20 – 2nd Grade

October 22 and 23 – 1st Grade

October 26 and 27 – Kindergarten

Families with students in multiple grade levels (K to 3 only) will bring siblings together following the schedule of their oldest sibling. For example, if you have a Kindergartner and a 2nd grader, you will bring both students on the day 2nd grade is scheduled to take the assessment.

We will follow CDC Guidelines by having your child test in our cafeteria where we can ensure they are 6 feet away from other students. Students will be required to wear their mask for the hour they are on campus. We will conduct the health screening and temperature check for each student as they enter the building.

We ask that you arrive on campus by 8:45, park, and walk your student to the front office door where they will be greeted by a Mighty Mustang staff member. Students will check in and be escorted directly to the cafe. The test will begin at 9:00 am and will conclude at 9:45 am. Students will then be escorted out the cafe doors to the front bus loop area for parents to pick up.

We are asking students that have a district computer, to please bring the computer for testing (MAKE SURE THE COMPUTER HAS A FULL CHARGE). ALL students need to bring a pencil and headphones. Students that DO NOT have a district computer will be given a school device that has been sanitized using all proper guidelines. We will provide scrap paper, a sanitized table area where they will work, and a disinfected computer.
