


Reading & Writing

By the end of the year the students should be able to:

- Recognize and produce all letter names and sounds.
- Fluently read 85 out of the 100 sight words we practice.
- Read non repetitive text using phonics and sight word Knowledge (an instructional level D)
- Be able to retell beginning, middle and end of a story (
- Draw and label a detailed picture related to a piece of personal writing.
- Spell words phonetically.
- Write a complete sentence using proper capitalization and end punctuation.






- By the end of the year the students should be able to:
