Focus Group Meeting Update - Stephanie Sanalila

- -SAC and PTA members from each school can attend the Focus Group Meeting
- -Teacher of the Year Awards were on agenda
- -District strategic plan was discussed
- -PTA requests need for technology need to be submitted to Principal first just to make sure they are vetted
- -Teaching hiring process is now occurring year round instead of yearly

Principal's Report – School Improvement Plan 2023-2024/Information

- -Dr. Goodwin explained what the School Improvement plan is and how SAC gives input to the SIP.
- -Dr. Goodwin explained what Early Warning Signs are and why we address it in the SIP.
- -Data from the 2022-2023 School Year:
- 227 out of 1850 students were absent more than 10 days.
- 197 out of 1850 students scored level 1 in ELA
- 114 out of 1850 students scored level 1 in Math

ELA Goal: MCA will increase the bottom quartile learning gains in ELA by 4% as measured by the FAST this school year. We will increase the learning gains in grades K-2 by 4% as measured by STAR this school year.

Math Goal: MCA will increase the bottom quartile learning gains in math by 5% as measured by the FAST this school year. We will increase the learning gains in grades K-2 by 5% as measured by STAR this school year.

Positive Culture Goal: We will reduce behavioral incidents by 5% by the end of the 2023 - 2024 SY.

Principal's Report – Celebrations / Updates

- Facilities is putting in shade structures out in front of the school and a fence to replace the brick wall that had to be removed because of structural damage (damaged by a sprinkler head).
- PTA raised money for shade structures on the playground and they are being put in now.
- We now have a weather station installed outside of the STEM room. Students will be using weather data in different STEM activities.
