### Proposal 2

10% of the School Recognition funds would be given to SAC for non-recurring expenses. The remaining 90% should be divided equally among all faculty and staff for the 22-23 school year. To be eligible for the full amount, you need to have worked 85% of the 22-23 school year and have been a full-time employee. All part time workers, including people hired throughout the year will receive a pro-rated amount based on their scheduled daily hours or % of the school year worked.
