Mill Creek Academy Application Process

In order to be considered for membership into the Mill Creek Academy Chapter of the National Junior Honor Society, you must follow all instructions.

1. Applications will be available for current 7th and 8th graders beginning **Wednesday, September 10th** and can be picked up from their homeroom teachers or Mrs. Abel (Portable 26).
2. Completed forms MUST be returned to Mrs. Abel in Portable 26 by **Friday, October 10th, 2025, by 3:00 p.m.**
3. A faculty selection committee appointed by the principal, consisting of five (5) faculty members, will review the applications and recommendations for final selections.
4. Membership decisions will be communicated via letter directly to students. Those accepted for membership will receive details regarding an Induction Ceremony in November.

Deadline for application: 3:00 p.m. on Friday October 10th

**** PLEASE NOTE: LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED ****

(Membership announcements will be made in October 2025.)

The application form must include:

- Rights and Responsibility Form
- Copy of your **most recent interim grades/report card**: The report card is used to determine if you meet the GPA requirement of a 3.75. GPA **does not** guarantee acceptance into the National Junior Honor Society program. You must print the Report Card from HAC – the Front Office will not print report cards for you.
- Leadership Form
- Service Form
- Citizenship Form
- Character Form
- **Three** teacher recommendation forms: It is **your responsibility** to put your name on the forms. You can only use **one** recommendation from an elective teacher. The other three must be from core teachers (ELA, Science, Math, History)
