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MILL CREEK ACADEMY ATHLETIC EVENT GUIDELINES

MCA strives to provide an enjoyable athletic environment for all guests attending events for the benefit of our student athletes, families and visiting opponents.

For the best possible sporting event experience, please review the following MCA expectations:

Tickets:

- Available through SchoolPay. A link will be emailed to purchase tickets for each event.
- All spectators are required to purchase a ticket.

Prohibited Items: MCA prohibits the following items to be brought into stadiums, playing fields, or gymnasium:

- Pets, except for Certified Service Animals
- Airhorns, and like items
- Backpacks

Gymnasium Expectations:

- **No food or drinks in stands**
- Food and/or drinks only in concession area
- If a student leaves the gymnasium building, they will not be granted re-entry and must contact a parent to pick them up.
- Playing or loitering in the hallway, stands, restroom, and concession area is not permitted.

Student Expectations:

- Students are not permitted to stay after school to wait for a game. They must go home and return at the time of the game.
- During sporting events, all areas of campus, other than location of event, are off-limits.

Students are expected to transition only between area of event and pickup/drop-off area in front of school.

All coaches, athletes, staff and spectators are expected to, and are held accountable for, representing their school with dignity and class by following guidelines set forth by Character Counts, Pursuing Victory with Honor, and the SJCS D Student Code of Conduct.

Any violation to the standards set by MCA and the SJCS D may be cause for removal from an event. Student behavioral concerns during the student school day may preclude a student from attending any sporting event at the discretion of school administration.
